

Transport

Support is available if you need help getting to any Silver Sunday activities.

The Dial-a-Ride service is available Monday to Friday and can help you make journeys across Sevenoaks District in comfort and safety.

A car can pick you up from your home and take you anywhere in the Sevenoaks District. The service uses a wheelchair accessible vehicle and their experienced driver will give you all the assistance you need.

Each single journey costs £2 for the first two miles, with an additional charge of £1 per mile. If you require a return journey, this will be charged separately.

Up to four people can travel together at no extra charge. The driver may be able to wait for short visits, at a charge of £2 for 30 minutes. The full cost of your journey will be confirmed when you make your booking.

You can book your journey up to seven days in advance by calling **01892 832447.**

Dial-a-Ride will confirm what time its driver will pick you up, and whether you require a return journey on the same day.
