#### Fake coronavirus testing kits

If someone knocks on your door asking if you want to buy a testing kit...say no thank you! Door to door scam people are in Sevenoaks, offering fake test kits for the virus, for £40. If you are worried that you may have the virus, it is much better to contact NHS 111 online or call NHS 111 and they will talk you through what to do. According to the NHS website, there is no need to test people with a cough or fever, so the best thing you can do for everyone is stay inside.

The weather has been beautiful and lots of birds are busy building nests.

Something you can do whilst at home, is spot as many birds as you can outside your window or open the window and listen to their song.



This is a picture of a Starling and may look quite familiar, and this is because they are quite common. Their song is full of chattering notes and mimicry of other birds.

Below is a Goldfinch They are distinguishable by their red faces, white cheeks, black crown and golden wingbar. Their voice is a sharp deedee-lit call.

The picture to the left shows an albino squirrel and a grey squirrel. You may not have ever seen an albino squirrel and that's because they're extremely rare! In fact, experts say there's only a 1 in 100000 chance that you will see one. This white squirrel has red eyes making it an albino.

The albino squirrels are now local.
