### 4 easy meals from one pan:

One of our residents enjoys cooking and suggests making a big batch of mince to use as a base for a shepherd's pie, chilli con carne or Spaghetti Bolognese. He divides the prepared mince into 4 containers and freezes them to use later.

#### He uses:

500g mince, 1 large onion, 1 red pepper, 2 garlic cloves, 1 tablespoon of oil. Any herbs or spices such as paprika, cumin, marjoram, thyme (1 teaspoon of each), 1 beef stock cube, 400g tin chopped tomatoes

#### Method:

Chop the onion, garlic and pepper, then heat the oil in a large pan, add chopped veg and cook till soft. Add the herbs and spices, stir and leave for 5 mins.

Add the mince to the pan and brown it slowly. Crumble the stock cube in 300ml hot water, mix well and add to the mince. Add the chopped tomatoes, and simmer gently. Bring to the boil, stir well put a lid on the pan. Turn down the heat so it is gently bubbling and leave for 20 mins. When cool, divide into 4 containers and freeze!
