If you are feeling a bit lonely and want to have a chat, please use the **Tunstall call system** and we will arrange for someone to call you back.





The Dean's Trifle

A favourite recipe of Derek's and his friends, is the Dean's Trifle. It is easy to make and has a wonderful blend of flavours. Derek uses Amontillado medium dry sherry and VSOP brandy. The decoration is, of course, optional.

Serves 8 The Dean's Trifle 8 oblong sponge cakes (bought The Dean of Trinity College, Cambridge, in the late in a packet) nineteenth century preferred this to any other trifle Raspberry jam and insisted that it should appear on the High Table Apricot jam ½ lb (120g) ratafia biscuits or Cut the sponge cakes in half lengthways. Lightly macaroons spread 8 halves with raspberry jam and 8 with $I_{\frac{1}{4}}^{1}$ cups (3dl) sherry apricot jam. Arrange them in a very large glass or $2\frac{1}{2}$ cups (6 dl) double cream china bowl, jam sides upwards and piled two or three 4 tablespoons (60 g) castor deep. Crumble the ratafias or macaroons and put sugar them with the sponge cakes. Pour over the sherry 1 cup brandy and leave to soak for at least 20 minutes. angelica Whip the cream, sugar and brandy as for a solid 3/4 cup (120 g) glacé cherries syllabub. Pile over the wine and cake mixture and cup (120g) crystallized decorate with angelica, cherries and pineapple. Chill for at least 1 hour before serving. pineapple
