TV Licencing and the changes that apply from the 1st August 2020

A summary of what this means for Rockdale residents

ARC preserved rights – Rockdale Gardens

Several Rockdale Gardens' residents have preserved rights (this means that they were granted this previously and it is honoured each year), which means:

- if over 75 there is no fee.
- under 75 is £7.50, which we pay and claim back via the Service charge.

New residents (Rockdale Gardens only)

All new residents will have to follow the new rules and pay themselves.

- Over 75 and in receipt of pension credit it is free but if not, you will need to pay the full cost.
- Under 75 will have to pay the full cost.

Residents in Rockdale's rented accommodation

- If you are over 75 there is no fee.
- under 75 is £7.50 which Rockdale pay for you and claim back via the Service charge.

Leasehold residents (Laurie House only)

- Leasehold residents will have to apply for their own licence.
- If over 75 and in receipt of pension credit it is free, but if not, you will need to pay the full cost.
- Under 75 will have to pay the full cost.
